The Mid-Western

Originally built in 1954, the home was revolutionary at the time for its T-shaped split-level plan, which allowed for a more spacious, two-story bedroom wing. The home was originally designed by the architecture firm Linscott, Kiene & Haylett, whose work can still be seen in many Kansas City area civic, business, religious, and educational structures. The Mid-Western was chosen by the Kansas City Star as the most popular house in the 1954 Parade of Homes and both the architecture firm and the builder, Jed K. Giles, were honored in 1956 by House and Home magazine for the Mid-Western's contribution to housing progress. The current owner wanted to honor the history of the house but also wanted to open up the main spaces to be more in keeping with 21st-century living and to have a larger and more gracious feel.

ART House

The project located just south of the Kansas City Country club Plaza, is a single-family row house. The site was the last remain ing lot in a block of eight houses facing a central park in a historic overlay district. This overlay required that the homes be built in a traditional vocabulary. Our clients were interested in creating contemporary architecture within the presented constraints. We worked to develop subtle modern detailing within the historic massing of the home. The interior of the house is developed around a double height living dining room on the main floor surrounded by a U shaped second floor gallery for the owners extensive art collection. A delicate bridge crosses the living room providing scale at the patio doors completing the gallery circulation.

Wurster Residence

This project is a full interior and exterior renovation and addition to a 1950s ranch in Mission Hills, KS, initially designed by William Wurster (1895–1973) as a spec house for Better Homes and Gardens. As a spec house, the material palette was dated and the plan needed to be updated to fulfill the client's needs. Despite the outdated finishes, the house is still architecturally significant and it was our intention to follow the language of the existing structure, while improving the spaces and updating quality of materials used.

Bridge House

This project is a full interior renovation to a 1950's ranch in Prairie Village, KS. The goal of this project was to rework the existing floor plan to create distinct rooms while creating continuous space. This was achieved by bisecting the plan with a wall of deep poché that houses the new master bedroom closets and the appliance | pantry wall of the kitchen. This wall creates a deep jamb condition further defining the rooms while maintaining an open, clear spatial relationship.

Union Hill Residence

FD|A was asked to remodel an existing one bedroom row house in Union Hill. The existing spaces were chopped up into multiple small rooms with dated and tired finishes. Due to the narrow and deep nature of the plan 16'x45', the existing stair, bathroom and kitchen locations were all maintained. Overall FD|A clarified and unified the space to make spaces that are defined for a functional purpose while being continuously linked spatially.

PoolHaus

Our client desired a pavilion that would provide a bath, shower/dressing area, outdoor kitchen, shaded living area, and mechanical systems housing for their new natural pool. The project presented two challenges. First, the structure could not exceed 200 square feet per city regulations. Second, the project site was a tight semi-urban lot, so we had limited space in which to locate the new structure and also retain some of the yard space and privacy from the neighbors.

Inspired by the concept of a delicate yet modern trellis, we developed the project as a pergola with discrete enclosed

areas that allowed us to meet the city's footage limit. A small freestanding pool house contains a private shower and dressing room as well as a covered outdoor kitchen. The pool deck wraps around the pool and integrates with the main house, connecting the two spaces and creating an outdoor lounge area.

Hipped House (Deleware) Residence

Originally constructed in the 1890's in Lawrence, Kansas, we transformed Delaware House into a modern home that suits the needs of its current owners while maintaining its historic charm. The house is located within a historic district, so any design changes had to follow the historic standards set by the Secretary of the Interior, and approval by the Lawrence Historic District Review Committee was required. For the interior of the home, we created a contemporary space through the use of continuously linked, discrete rooms. The kitchen is situated under a flat ceiling, while the living and dining spaces boast a hipped vaulted ceiling. Thick bearing walls work to further define these rooms within the overall space.

Kanso Pop-Up

This project is a full interior and exterior renovation to a 1920's Italianate residence in Country Club Hills, MO. The architectural style and quality of the 1920's house is largely intact on the exterior, but subsequent interior renovations and an addition completed in the 1980's has left the house disorganized and architecturally confused. Our design intent is to correct the plan and massing of the house in keeping with the original Italianate style. The design of the interior renovation will take on a new character that is also in keeping with the formality of the original design but doing so with contemporary materials and detailing. The interplay between thickened walls and openings with intricate detailing and material consideration will create an interior that is both comforting and delicate.
