2015 Chicago Healthcare Student Design Charrette

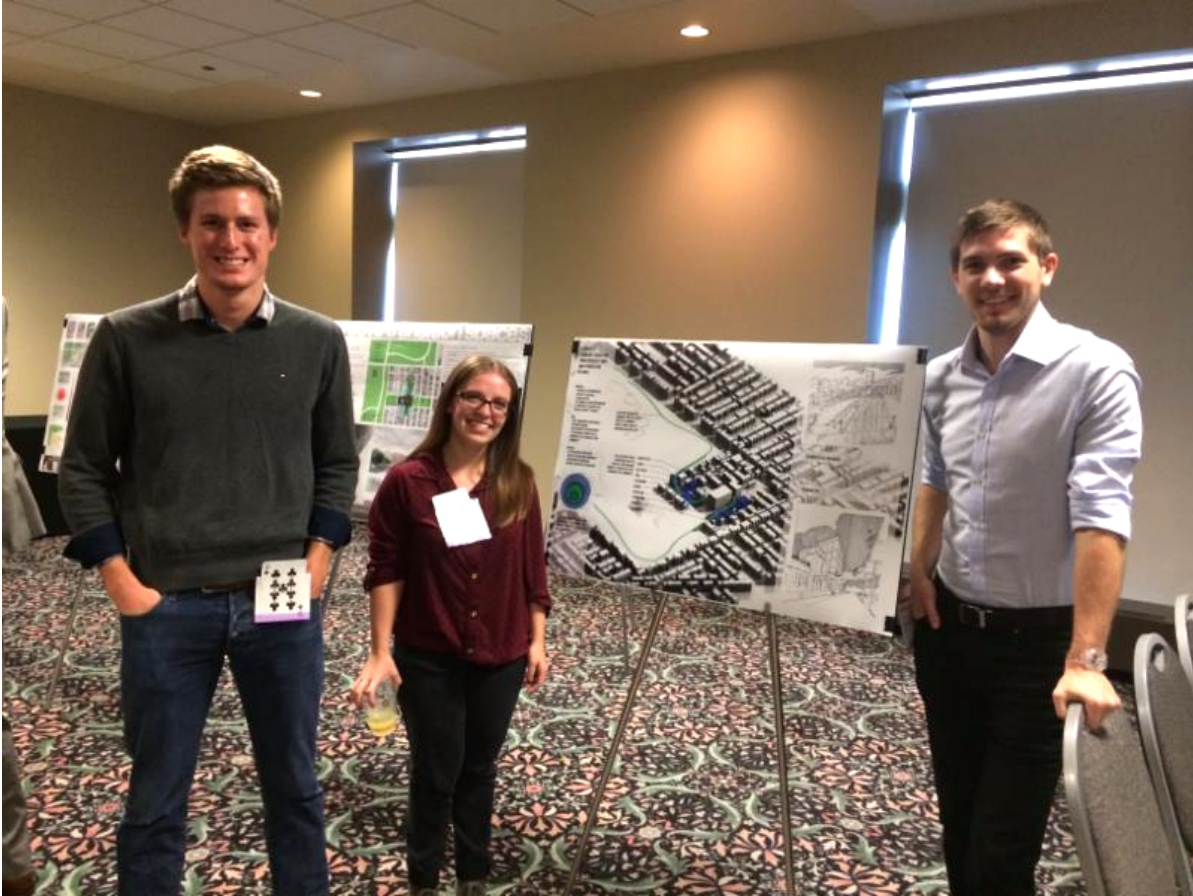

Jacob Kelly-Salo, Christopher Sanford and Kendra Vander Baan, three graduate students in architecture, traveled to Chicago to participate in the 2015 Chicago Healthcare Student Design Charrette, a 3-day design intensive. Part of the Healthcare Facilities Symposium and Expo, the charrette was sponsored by the Chicago AIA, the Caritas Project and Assa Abloy, a lock manufacturing company. Titled "Realizing Behavioral Health and Well-Being in the Village", the K-State students worked with professionals of the architecture firm Perkins Will on developing conceptual design ideas to integrate a small hospital into the Humboldt Park neighborhood of Chicago. Professor Susanne Siepl-Coates accompanied the students and served as faculty advisor.

Teams from Iowa State, Philadelphia University, the New York School of Interior Design and Texas A& M University also participated in the charrette.
