The Large CNC router, and Plasma CNC are yet to be operational. Univerisity plumbers are making final connections today and tomorrow. Fabrication Labs Orientation and Training for individual students will start later this week. Keep an eye out for an email with a link to the online signup and updated policies. This will cover a general overview of the spaces and equipment, as well as a hands-on training for basic woodworking machines.
