Victor L. Regnier Distinguished Visiting Professorship

"This year's Victor L. Regnier Distinguished Visiting Professorship, world-renowned Portuguese architect Gonalo Byrne, joins the KCDC studio this week for the first of his three teaching visits to Kansas City this spring. With the 2-year long, NEA-funded, vision study for public spaces in the West Bottoms already in full swing, students are excited for the opportunity to have Professor Byrne's input and guidance as they investigate the morphology of the West Bottoms and study potential project sites. Professor Bryne's next visit to Kansas City will be the week of March 13th and his final visit will be the week of April 10th, at which time he will be giving a public lecture at the Kansas City Central Library on April 13th.
