8 non-baccalaureate track MRCP degrees were awarded in 2012.
 4 post-baccalaureate track MRCP degrees were awarded in 2012.

Graduation Rates

Students enrolled in the non-baccalaureate track of the MRCP degree complete five years of study, three as an undergraduate and two in the graduate program. The 2012 seven-year graduation rate for students' enrolled in the non-baccalaureate MRCP is 75%.
 Students enrolled in the post-baccalaureate track of the MRCP degree complete two years of graduate study. The 2012 four-year graduation rate for students enrolled in the post-baccalaureate MRCP is 80%.

Retention Rates

The percentage of students returning for their final year of study in the non-baccalaureate track of the MRCP program in 2012 was 100%.
 The percentage of students returning for their final year of study in the post-baccalaureate track of the MRCP program in 2012 was 100%.

AICP Exam Pass Rate:

100% of MRCP graduates opting to take the American Institute of Certified Planners examination within three years of graduating passed the exam.

Employment Rate

77% of the 13 RCP Program 2011 graduates are employed. The employment status of 23% of the 2011 graduates is unknown.
