## ABOUT

The minor in community planning is for students who wish to expand their knowledge of community planning and development processes. The minor is open to all majors and is especially suited for those interested in the quality of life in communities. To earn the minor in community planning, students are required to complete 15 credit hours of planning courses with grades of C or better.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

### Core requirements

- Successful completion of the following planning courses:
- PLAN 315: Introduction to City Planning (3 credits, fall, online in summer)
- PLAN 215: World Cities (3 credits, spring)

### Additional requirements

Successful completion of nine credit hours of planning (PLAN) electives.

## DECLARE THIS MINOR

Students may declare this minor by contacting the LARCP advising liaison. To receive certification of the minor, declaration must be completed before enrolling in the nine credit hours of planning electives.
